

Sex offender records (GRS-360)

Utah General Retention Schedule

Description

Records maintained by state and local law enforcement agencies in order to document sex offenders living within their jurisdictions, as required by federal and state law.

Retention and Disposition

Retain for 10 years after separation, and then destroy records.

Retention Justification Note

Separation means the offender as moved from jurisdiction.

Appraisal

These records have administrative, and/or legal value(s).

Appraisal Note

These records have legal value based on the usefulness to document and protect the rights and interests of an individual or organization, to demonstrate compliance with laws and regulations, or to meet other legal needs. Specifically, Utah Code 77-41-105(3)(a)(2019).
