Information includes client name, social security number, county code, description of patient's condition or symptom's, diagnosis, medical history, laboratory results, provider name and address, medication, notice of denial and patients' hearing requests, hearing outcome, third party investigation, and employment status. These case files are used only for Davis County, and are maintained at the Clearfield facility. The Clearfield office does not have a clinic, therefore all clients are referred to other local authorized medical facilities.
